Vaccination Policy

To prevent the spread of disease while your pet is in our care, dogs must be current on rabies, bordetella (within the past 6 months) and distemper vaccinations. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide proof of vaccination history for each pet boarded. The vaccinations must have been administered by a veterinarian. Animals whose shots are not up to date will not be allowed to board. To insure the protection of all the pets under our care, the following vaccinations must be up to date 5 days prior to boarding.

Medical / Illness Policy

Owner acknowledges that, in the unlikely event your dog becomes ill or injured, or if your dog has a pre-existing condition, which is aggravated by his or her stay, and requires professional attention, we will attempt to notify you or your emergency contact at the phone numbers provided. Alpha Dogs Training Center, Inc., at its sole discretion, may engage the services of a 24-hour emergency veterinary clinic or a veterinarian of our choice and/or administer medicine or give other necessary attention to your dog, and you authorize us to provide any such service at your additional expense. In cases we believe to be critical, we may take your dog to the veterinarian first before trying to contact you. If you refuse medical treatment for your dog, Alpha Dogs Training Center, Inc., at its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian and/or administer medicine to make your dog as comfortable as possible until picked up by you or your emergency contact, and you authorize us to provide any such service at your additional expense. If we cannot reach you or your emergency contact, we will make health care decisions for your dog based on the recommendations of available professionals.

Disclaimers & Additional Provisions Relating to Boarding and Group Play

CDU is happy to offer the opportunity for your dog to be boarded here and participate in group play. In order for us to offer these valuable and quality services, we have developed the following set of provisions and disclaimers, which you must carefully read and agree to before allowing your pet to participate in group play, or boarding your dog at Alpha Dogs Training Center, Inc.

(1) Group play is for happy, healthy dogs that are spayed or neutered. Play group is not recommended for dogs that have medical conditions such as diabetes, seizures, heart murmurs or any other medical condition that may be aggravated by excitement or rough play. CDU assumes no responsibility for the aggravation of any medical disorders caused by your dog's participation in group play, and owner agrees that in such event, the provisions of section (3) below, shall not apply.

(2) Group play is not for dogs with temperament problems such as aggression or extreme shyness with either dogs or people. If your dog exhibits any of these behaviors, he or she will be removed from the play group and not allowed to return.

(3) Standard precautions will be used against the injury, escape or death of this pet. The CDU Staff will not be held responsible for injuries that occur, provided standard care and precautions have been followed as determined at the sole discretion of Alpha Dogs Training Center, Inc. It is expressly agreed by Owner and Alpha Dogs Training Center, Inc. that CDU's liability shall in no event exceed the lesser of the current chattel value of a pet of the same species or the sum of \$200.00 (Two Hundred Dollars) per animal boarded. In no event shall CDU be liable for illnesses that arise during Owner's pet's stay or after Owner's pet has left the facility.

(4) Owner understands and agrees that inherent risks are being taken by Owner should they elect to allow their pet access to agility obstacles, play groups and kiddie wading pools. These risks include, but are not limited to, dermatologic issues, injury from slipping, death by drowning, and injuries and illnesses caused by interaction with other animals and humans. Owner agrees that any injury or illness of their pets incurred during their pet's use of the wading pool or in play group shall not bring about any liability of any type on the part of CDU, and the provisions of section (3) above, shall not apply in the event of any injury or illness which occurs to owner's pet(s) during pet's use of the wading pool or in play group.

(5) Owner understands and agrees that the Owner is solely responsible for any harm caused by Owner's

dog(s) while boarding at CDU. Owner further understands and agrees that in admitting Owner's dog to CDU all health and behavior problems have been fully disclosed to the best of Owner's knowledge.

(6) CDU reserves the right to refuse to accept a pet if at check-in it appears to us, at our sole discretion, that such pet is sick or that its behavior could jeopardize the health or safety of other pets or our staff.

(7) Owner agrees and understands that there are inherent risks of illness or injury when dealing with animals and humans in a group situation. Such risks include, but are not limited to: problems associated with rough play such as bite wounds and scratches, kennel cough or other communicable diseases, and in rare instances death. Owner understands and agrees that under no circumstances shall CDU be responsible for illness or injury to pets participating in group play, and that in such event, the provisions of section (3), above, shall not apply. Should a death occur, the state of Colorado requires that the animal be taken to a veterinarian for storage until the owner returns and can claim the pet. The veterinarian shall be the Animal Clinic of Parker.

(8) Owner understands and agrees to the charges for boarding at CDU. Drop off and pick up times must be scheduled with CDU prior to drop off. Late pickups must be prearranged through CDU and late pickups may incur an additional fee.

(9) Owner understands that it is CDU policy that any dog boarded over 4 consecutive days will be bathed prior to departing the facility. Owner understands that CDU does not have a professional groomer on-site at all times, therefore; your dog will be bathed by a (trained) Animal Care Technician. If owner requests their dog to be bathed by a professional groomer, this must be scheduled with Management and the professional groomer on staff. If your dog is bathed by one of our professional groomers, the total cost per dog is \$35.

(10) Owner understands that CDU is not a 24-hour facility. Kennels are not monitored between 5 pm and 7 am. Pets requiring overnight care, or medical monitoring or services beyond oral medications or non-invasive treatments should not board in our facility. Owner asserts that all known medical and behavioral history of pet has been disclosed to CDU before boarding. Pets with casts, restricted mobility requirements, feeding tubes or post-operative recovery requirements may not board.

(11) If pet is to be boarded anytime over the holiday period (11/15 - 12/5 and 12/15 - 1/5), Owner understands that a non-refundable deposit of \$75 (per kennel reserved) is required in order to secure a holiday reservation. Credit card on file will be used to process this payment. Deposit will be applied to holiday boarding bill. If holiday boarding bill is less than applied Holiday Deposit(s), the difference will not be refunded. Owner agrees to the following holiday cancellation policies:

a) If entire reservation is canceled - Owner forfeits Holiday Deposit. If canceled with less than a seven day notice, owner also subject to cancellation fee outlined in Item #8.

b) If only a portion of reservation is canceled with less than a seven day notice (late check in, early check out, etc.) - Owner will be charged a cancellation fee equal to the number of days deleted from reservation, not to exceed the amount of the Holiday Deposit (\$75), for each kennel reserved.

(12) CDU prefers clients to stay within standard scheduling for food, treats, medication and AM and PM elimination breaks. CDU provides two meals, medication and treat times per day (Morning and Evening). Any special requests for times other than this are subject to an additional fee per animal, per time. Client will be advised of such fee at time of check in.

(13) All charges incurred by the Owner under this agreement shall be due and payable in full upon pick up of the pet. Owner agrees that the pet shall not leave CDU until such time as all charges incurred by the Owner have been paid in full to CDU.

(14) This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties. All terms and conditions of this contract shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of Owner and CDU.

(15) If any legal action is brought to enforce the provisions of this contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees. These fees, which may be set by the court in the same action or in a different action brought for that purpose, are in addition to any other relief to which the prevailing party may be entitled. Owner agrees that venue for any action or proceeding filed under this contract shall be in Elbert County, Colorado.

(16) Owner agrees and understands that in the event that any portion of this agreement shall be found void or unenforceable for any reason all other portions of the agreement will remain in full force and effect.

(17) This agreement covers the current relationship between CDU and yourself. Each time you bring your dog to CDU, you affirm the terms of this Agreement, and the truthfulness and accuracy of all statements you make in this Agreement.

I HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO ALL PROVISIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT. I fully intend to pick up my pet on the above specified date. If circumstances change I will notify CDU of the new pick up date and assume responsibility for any additional charges incurred.

I hereby waive and release CDU and their employees from any and all liability for injury or damage resulting from the actions of my dog, any other dog, or any human in the play groups or during swimming in the wading pool. I expressly assume the risk of any injury to my dog including any and all medical expenses resulting from or relating to said injury, subject to the stipulations set forth in the Medical / Illness policy above.

I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless CDU, its employees, officers, members, agents, and guests from any and all claims resulting from any action(s) by any dog in the play group, on the agility obstacles or during the use of the wading pool (including my dog) and that this release and indemnification shall be in force whenever my dog participates in the community play group, on the agility course or uses the wading pool starting with the date indicated below and thereafter.
